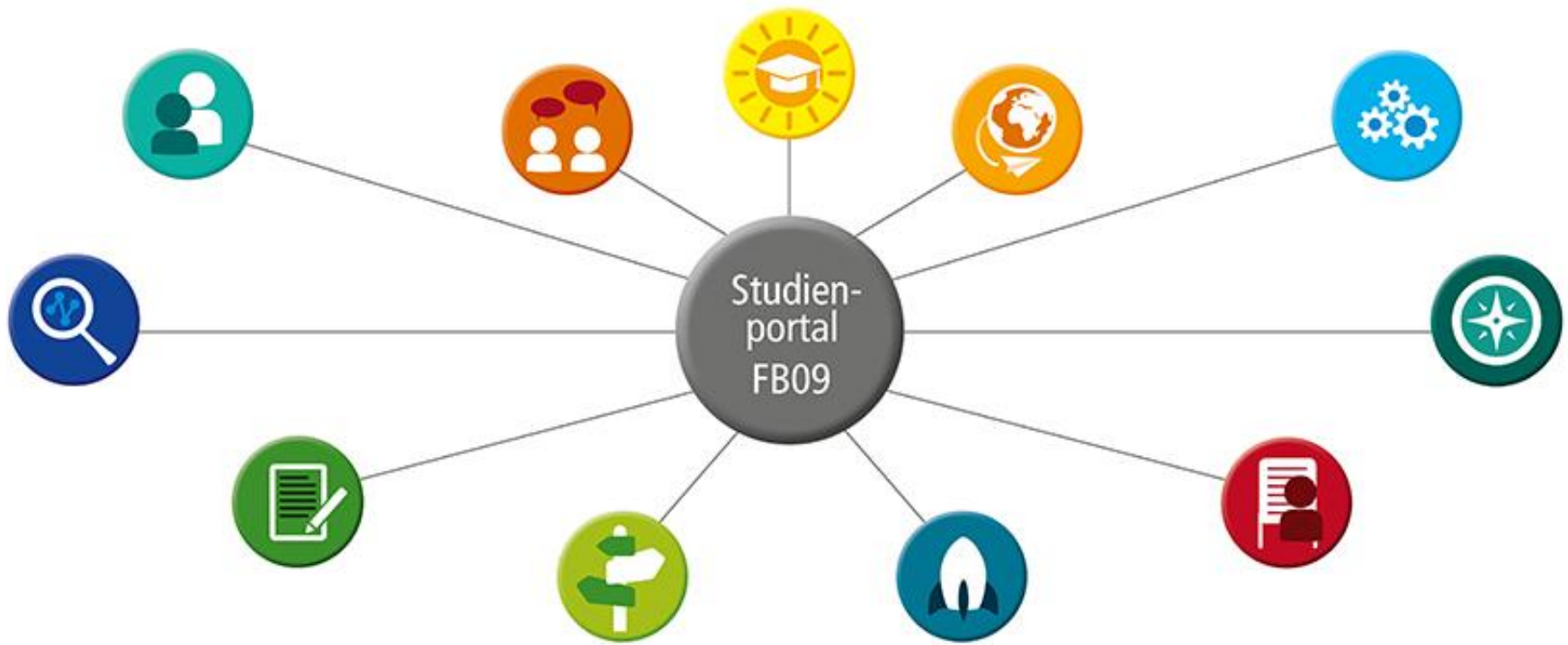

ERASMUS+ Studying Abroad

Studying Abroad at a Partner University (2 - 12 month/study phase)

Requirements for ERASMUS application:

- be enrolled at JGU and intend to complete a degree
- have completed at least 2 academic semesters (Bachelor students)
- intermediate level of instruction language

Advantages:

- simplified admission procedure
- no tuition fees
- partial scholarship
- combinable with BaföG grant and support abroad
- special grant for students with children or with disabilities
- simplified recognition of academic work abroad

ERASMUS+ Studying Abroad

Application at Faculty 09:

- The selection procedure takes place within the Faculty.
- The scholarship application takes place at JGU International Office (ERASMUS+).

Application Documents:

- CV
- Motivation Letter (important: 1 or 2 semesters? winter term or summer term?)
- School Leaving Certificate (German Abitur Certificate)
- Transcript of Records
- Language Certificate (if applicable)
- Other documents

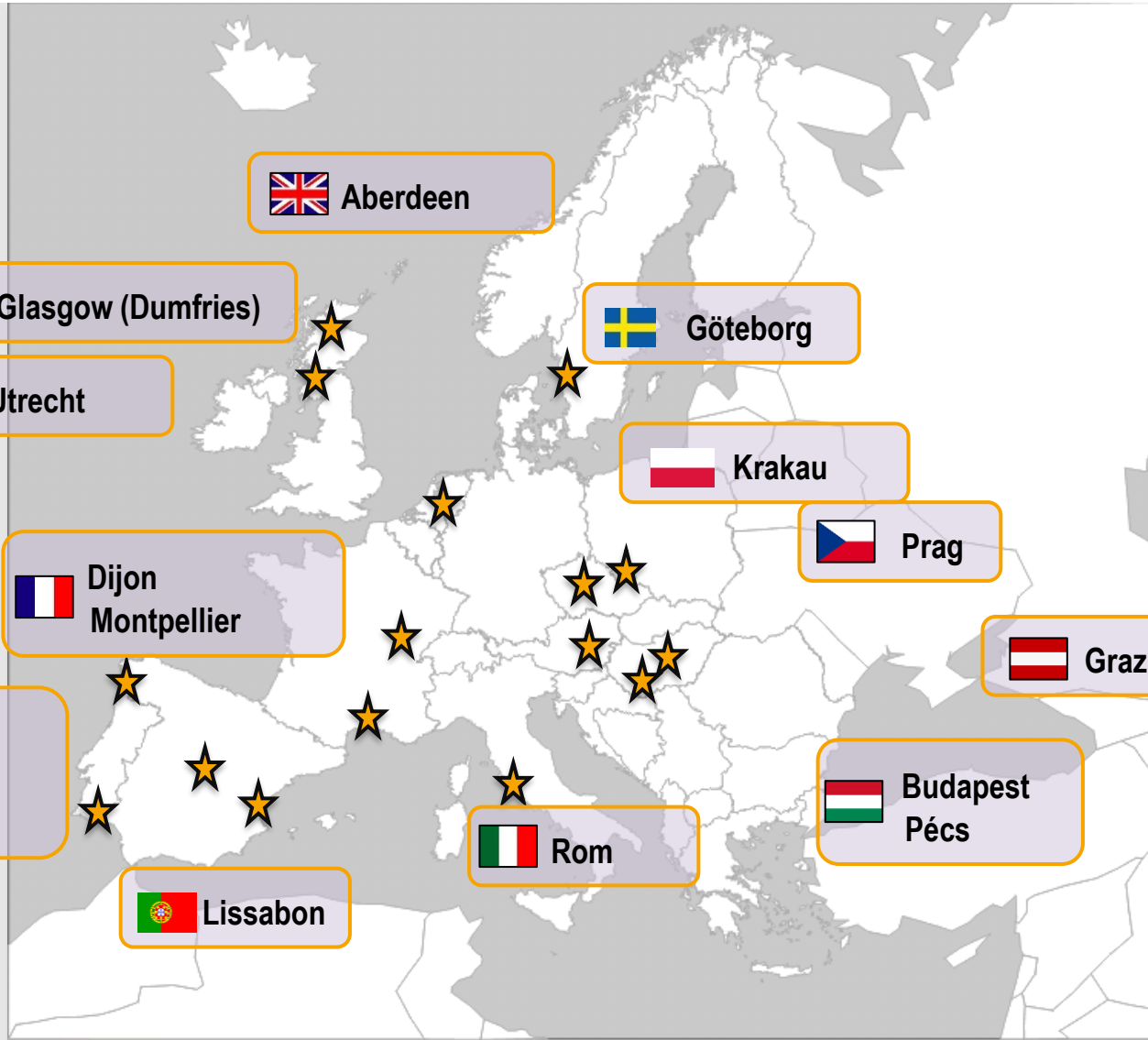

ERASMUS+ Internship

Internship (at least 60 days – 6 month) in an European Country and worldwide

Requirements:

- be enrolled at JGU and intend to complete a degree
- content-related to your subject
- full-time internship (at least 35 hours/week)

Application:

- apply for an extern internship, e.g. in a company or university
- apply for scholarship JGU International Office
- EU-ServicePoint: <https://www.eu-servicepoint.de>

Scholarship:

- partial scholarship
- special: scholarship for graduates
- special grant for students with children or disabilities



PROMOS

Study, Internship, Language Course, Thesis Research (- 6month)

Requirements:

- be enrolled at JGU and intend to complete a degree

Application:

- JGU International Office
- various deadlines/year depending on funding line

Scholarship value for studying abroad :

- usually partial scholarship rate (depending on destination country)
- travel allowance
- tuition fees are not reimbursed !

Further Funding Opportunities:

BAföG grants for studies abroad

- reimbursement of tuition fees up to 4.600 Euro for a maximum period of one year
- reimbursement of travel expenses
- subsidy to health insurance
- monthly subsidy to living expenses

DAAD (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst)

- annual scholarships; short-term scholarships
- for students, graduates, PhD students

Scholarship for partnerships of JGU

- no tuition fees
- partial reimbursement of accommodation expenses
- administrative support in Mainz and at the partner university
