

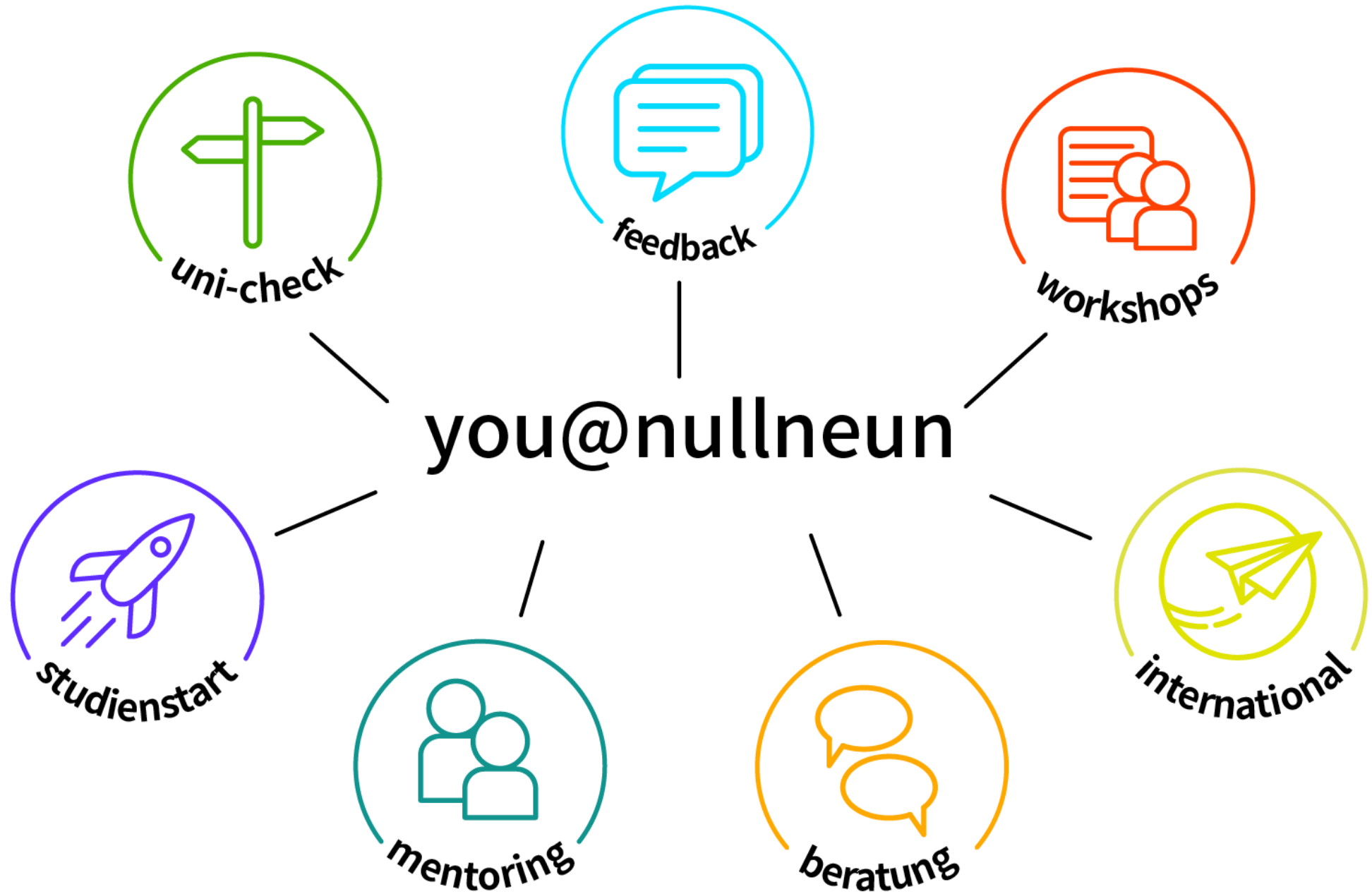

ERASMUS+ Study Abroad

Administrative requirement:

- ERASMUS+ agreement between Institute of Geography Mainz and partner university

Application procedure:

1. Apply at Institute for Geography (Sommerlad/Schellack)
2. Apply at JGU International Office (ERASMUS+) for scholarship



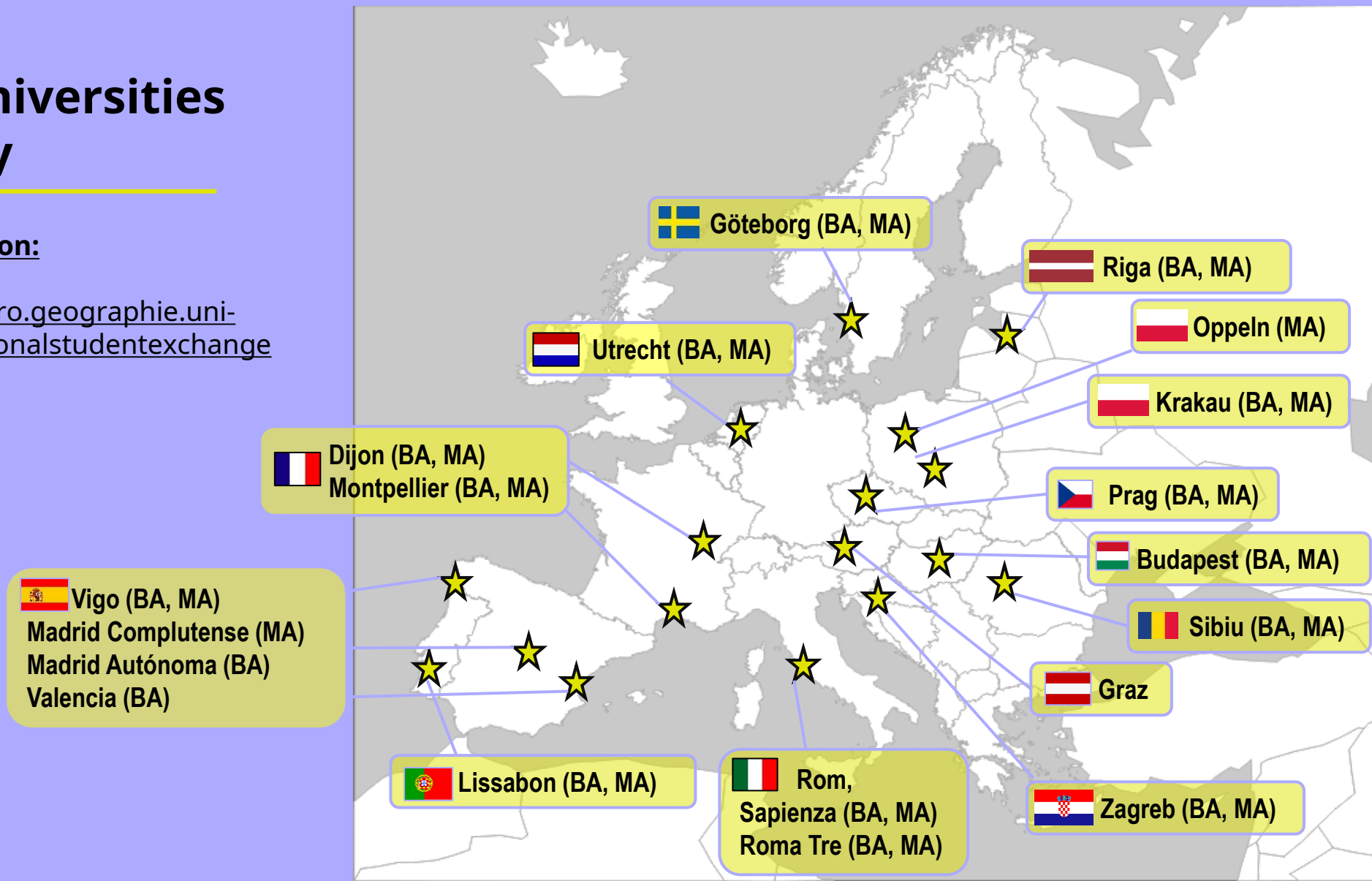

ERASMUS+ Study Abroad - Scholarship

**ERASMUS+ European partner country
(60 days - 12 month/study phase)**

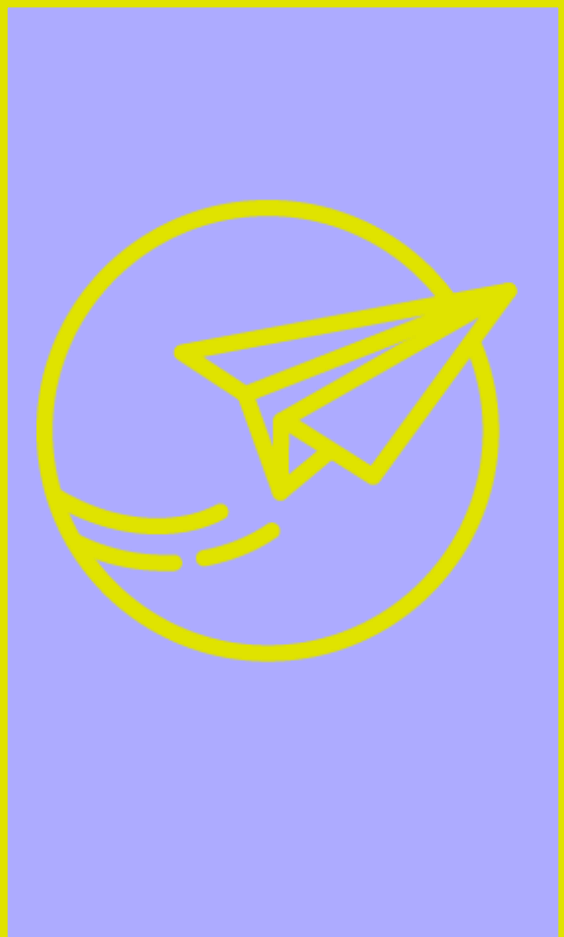
Requirements for ERASMUS application:

- be enrolled at JGU and intend to complete a degree
- intermediate level of instruction language

Advantages:

- simplified admission procedure and support abroad
- no tuition fees
- partial scholarship (490 €/month – 600 €/month)
- combinable with other grants
- special grant for students with children, with disabilities, first-time graduates, student job cannot be continued abroad
- simplified recognition of academic work abroad

Erasmus+ Study Abroad - Application

Application Documents:

- CV
- Motivation Letter (important: winter term or summer term?)
- School Leaving Certificate (German Abitur Certificate)
- Transcript of Records
- Language Certificate (if applicable)
- Other documents (e.g. social commitment in clubs, honorary positions, language tandems, cooperation with AStA)

Deadline:

- **15 January 2023**
- Submit as a PDF file titled „**ERASMUS-Application_Last Name_First Name**“.

Scholarship:

- 640 EUR/month – 750 EUR/month

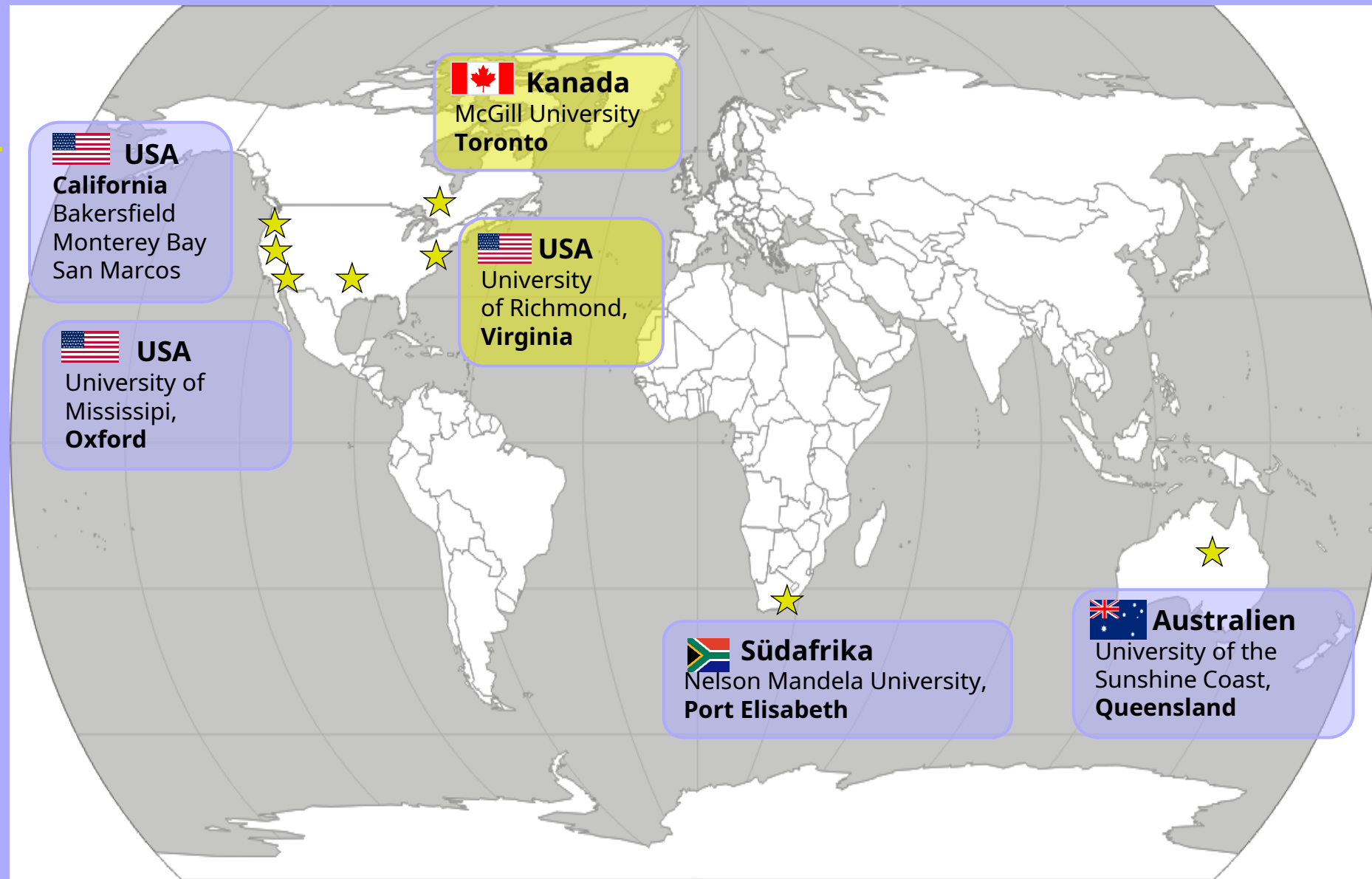

PROMOS – Programm zur Steigerung der Mobilität von deutschen Studierenden

Study, Internship, Language Course, Thesis Research (- 6month)

Requirements:

- be enrolled at JGU and intend to complete a degree

Application:

- JGU International Office
- various deadlines/year depending on funding line

Scholarship value for studying abroad :

- usually partial scholarship rate (depending on destination country)
- travel allowance
- tuition fees are not reimbursed !

DAAD (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst)

- annual scholarships; short-term scholarships
- for students, graduates, PhD students
